



Research Assistant: Data Analyst

The Environmental Performance Index (EPI), a project of the Yale Center for Environmental Law & Policy, is a biennial report that ranks 180 countries according to their performance on 20 indicators of sustainability. Duties

- Download and clean datasets;
- Document code and workflow;
- Conduct basic data exploration and visualizations; and
- Work with the principal investigator on other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Experience using R
- Coursework on data analysis

Preferences

- Experience or familiarity with international datasets related to sustainability
- Availability to extend position through Fall 2017

Pay will be at established Yale rates. The position will require 40 hours per week; hours are generally flexible. This position also can be offered as independent study for course credit.
